rapid strep (results real time - in office test)	\$10

psa - <b>test tip:</b> how's your prostate?	\$45
lead - <b>test tip:</b> used to check for lead levels, primarily in young kiddos	\$35
rheumatoid factor - <b>test tip:</b> a test to run when arthritis is suspected.	\$30
cbc with diff - <b>test tip:</b> a look at your blood - could help us identify reasons for fatigue and also if infection is present.	\$25
metabolic panel - <b>test tip:</b> a complete look at electrolyte status and a glimpse of kidney function	\$30
lipid panel - <b>test tip:</b> how's that cholesterol work coming along?	\$25
A1C - <b>test tip:</b> how high have your blood sugars been trending?	\$25
TSH - <b>test tip:</b> is your thyroid struggling?	\$30
hepatic function - <b>test tip:</b> how's your liver functioning?	\$30
bilirubin - <b>test tip:</b> another liver lab study.	\$25
lipase - <b>test tip:</b> how's your pancreas doing?	\$25
crp - <b>test tip:</b> a way to see if your body is experiencing inflammation.	\$35
urine culture - <b>test tip:</b> a step beyond a urinalysis - what antibiotic will knock out a urinary tract infection?	\$55
urinalysis (complete) - <b>test tip:</b> an indicator of infection in your urine.	\$40
respiratory panel (influenza A and B and rsv) - <b>test tip:</b> nasal swab checking for influenza and RSV	\$165
rsv and covid-19 swab - <b>test tip:</b> nasal swab to test for rsv and covid-19.	\$170
covid IgG antibody - <b>test tip:</b> a check to see if you have detectable antibody levels from a previous covid-19 infection	\$60
pap and hpv - <b>test tip:</b> this is a routine test for women - as part of their annual well woman exam.	\$250
male/female std - <b>test tip:</b> comprehensive check for sexually transmitted infections.	diagnosis dependent
lyme with reflex - <b>test tip:</b> one way to check for lymes.	diagnosis dependent
hcg (qualitative serum) - <b>test tip:</b> blood work to tell positive or negative pregnancy hormones	\$35

<b>hcg</b> (quantitative serum) – <b>test tip:</b> blood work providing numbers for hcg level trend. . . . .	\$50
<b>testosterone</b> (free and total) – <b>test tip:</b> a way to see your testosterone levels which may explain specific symptoms in men and women. . . . .	\$70
<b>vitamin d</b> – <b>test tip:</b> many midwesterners are low - are you? could supplementing your diet help mood and bone health?. . . . .	\$50
<b>vitamin b12 and folate</b> – <b>test tip:</b> does a vitamin b12 deficiency explain any of your symptoms? . . . . .	\$45
<b>ferritin</b> – <b>test tip:</b> this may help explain low energy! . . . . .	\$35
<b>iron total and tbc</b> – <b>test tip:</b> is your body using iron/ferritin effectively? . . . . .	\$35
